Official Ballot Nonpartisan Office and Referendum April 4, 2017

Notice to Voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials)

IMPORTANT: It is recommended to use an official ballot marking pen available at your polling place or a #2 pencil.

Instructions to Voters

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, see an election inspector. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

To vote for a name on the ballot, complete the arrow next to the name like this ←

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in," and complete the arrow next to the name like this ←

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,200,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District of Saint Croix Falls, Polk County, Wisconsin that there shall be issued pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,200,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school improvement and maintenance program at District facilities and grounds consisting of: HVAC and mechanical upgrades; classroom, library and interior improvements; safety and security upgrades; roof replacement; lighting and electrical improvements; athletic facility, bus garage, parking and site improvements; and acquisition of furnishings, fixtures and equipment?
