

TOWN OF OSCEOLA TAX INFORMATION

DOG LICENSING Dog licenses are required in the Town of Osceola. The 2019 Dog License Application is on the reverse side on this notice. Licenses must be obtained prior to April 1, 2019. Dog licenses are \$7.00 for spayed and neutered dogs and \$12.00 for non-spayed and non-neutered dogs.

LOTTERY CREDIT If this tax residence is your primary residence and you have resided there since January 1, 2018 (or before) and there is **NOT** a lottery credit deduction on your tax bill, call the Town Office at (715)755-3060 to get forms in order to receive this credit. PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE TO APPLY FOR THIS LOTTERY CREDIT.

CONVENIENT WAYS TO PAY YOUR TAXES

U.S. MAIL

- For income tax purposes, any end-of-month tax payments received after December 31 but “postmarked” by December 31, 2018 will be receipted “December 31, 2018.”

24 HOUR DROP OFF

- A mail drop slot is located inside the entry foyer at the Town Hall and is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

IN PERSON

- 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday – Wednesday and 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. Thursday - Friday.

CREDIT CARD OR E-CHECK PAYMENTS

- For your convenience, you may pay by credit card or e-check at townofosceola@yahoo.com or in the treasurer’s office. A 2.39% convenience fee is charged for credit card payments and \$1.50 is charged for e-check payments by Point and Pay, credit card service provider.
