The Public Works Committee for the Town of Osceola met for a regular monthly meeting Thursday, August 28, 2025, at 7:00 am at the Osceola Town Hall (garage), Dresser, Wisconsin.

Call Meeting to Order: Chair Lindh called the meeting to order at 7:01 am.

Discussion about current / future road projects

- Summer 2024 road projects:
 - 70th Ave- pulverizing / repaving:
 - Monarch will repatch in summer small area due to soil being soft along with 90th Ave and 200th St
 - Dug hole and excavated the clay patch that created the brake up in the road
- Summer 2025 road projects:
 - Spray Patching
 - 7 miles have been completed
 - Wait to finish in fall (late August / September)
 - Crack Seal
 - 5 miles still needs to be completed
 - Chip Seal
 - 7.4 miles
 - Have pre-bought and hauled FA-2 ¼" chip rock for this year
 - Looking to start this project on September 3rd or 4th
 - GSB 88
 - completed: 2.8 miles
 - Micro Seal
 - Completed: 1.7 miles
 - Gravel Lift
 - 4 miles 60th Ave and 70th Ave may push to next year
 - Pulverizing
 - 70th Ave east of Dwight Lane- possible fall start
 - Todd will request a quote for the work- still waiting on getting quote
 - Paving
 - No paving projects this year
 - Shouldering
 - Completed
 - Wedging
 - Intersection of 90th Ave and 200th St-
 - Waiting on Monarch to resurface
 - Culverts
 - (8) culverts on 60th Ave
 - Planning on starting in September after chip seal is complete
 - Stripping
 - 1.27 miles

- Oak Drive .8, Big Lake Drive .47
- Discussion on patching on repairing potholes as needed
 -
- Ditch moving / brush trimming:
 - Second pass is half done
- Trees:
 - Working on picking up trees in ditches
- Sand / salt shed is 10% full.
 -
- PASER Road Ratings need to be completed by December 15, 2025.
 - Todd is taking notes on road conditions as he is working on the roads
- Road Grants:
 - Looking for possible new road grants
- Parks and Boat Landing

- Speed sign
 - Installed on 235th St

Miscellaneous

- Looking at having another Electronic Recycling Event on September 27, 2025
- Discussed buy diesel fuel storage tank to have at Town Hall.

Discussion about the current Public Works budget:

- One ton truck dump:
 - Discussion of possible future upgrade of one-ton truck. Possibly 2027
 - Need new back tires in the fall.
- Old Mack Truck
 - Should replace steering tires in late summer possible \$2,000 (may wait until 2026)
- International Truck
- Backhoe
 - Need to fix front bucket by adding more steel to underside
 - AC & throttle cable needs to be fixed
 - Transmission has been slipping when in high gear
- Road Grader
- Spray Patcher:
 - Waiting on ordering parts to determine if we are buying a different patcher
 - Also consider replacing it with a new used model at the end of year. Looking at on-line auction.
- New Mack dump truck.
 - Need to have a couple of recalls done on the truck. Scheduled for fall.
- Side mover pump broke. New pump was ordered for \$5000.
- Went over the current budget and future purchases.
 - Consider upgrading the spray patcher (currently have used ours for 3 years)
 - Consider buying Degal sidearm for mower. (This will allow the tractor to stay on the road and move the mower into the ditch.)
 - Todd to see if he can make a similar attachment for \$2,000 to \$3,000
 - Consider buying 40ft storage container – Todd / Lanette to look at cost. Lanette estimated cost around \$4,000
 - Discussion of possible future office build-out for shop. Todd received one quote on work and looking to get another quote.
 - Looked at getting quote to seal Town Hall parking lot.
 - Look at purchasing new seasonal weight limit signs
- Looking into Maple Court- It is a private road not a town road. The town will send out a letter stating that we will not be servicing this road.
- Looking into Eagle Bluff roads complaint that these should be taken over by Town.
- The Town was contacted about have invasive grasses in ditches near the Rod and Gun Club
