- Discussion on patching on repairing potholes as needed.
  - Need to install bump sign on 70<sup>th</sup> Ave.
  - Worked on fixing potholes: 90<sup>th</sup> Ave, 60<sup>th</sup> Ave, 210<sup>th</sup> Street
- Ditch moving / brush trimming:
  - Trimming brush as time allows.: 240<sup>th</sup> Street, Clark Road, Oak Drive

- Discussed buy diesel fuel storage tank to have at Town Hall.
  - A 500-gallon tank has been installed.

**Discussion about the current Public Works budget:**

- One ton truck dump:
  - Discussion of potential future upgrade of one-ton truck. Possibly in 2027
  - Needs new back tires have been installed
- Old Mack Truck
  - Should replace steering tires in fall of 2026: \$2,000.
  - Had to weld plow frame
- New Mack dump truck.
  - No concerns
- International Truck
  - Consider placing on Facebook marketplace to sell truck
- Backhoe
  - New backhoe will be delivered next week.
- Road Grader
- Spray Patcher:
  - Todd is currently working with lawyers to determine next steps to obtain new purchases.
  - City is willing to sell spray patcher for \$25,000
- Tractor
  - We are having multiple hydraulic leaks when trimming brush with mower.
- Radio
  - New radios still are not programmed properly.
- Discussed shop office build out.
  - HVAC has been completed.
- Went over the current budget and future purchases.
  - Consider buying Degal sidearm for mower. (This will allow the tractor to stay on the road and move the mower into the ditch.)
    - Todd to see if he can make a similar attachment for \$2,000 to \$3,000. (Purchased frame for \$500)
  - Look at purchasing new seasonal weight limit signs will do this at end of year if budget allows.
- Looking into Maple Court- It is a private road not a town road.- Jon Cronick
- Todd talked to DNR about installing new culvert on 200<sup>th</sup> Street- no updates at this time.
