The Public Works Committee for the Town of Osceola met for a regular monthly meeting Thursday, June 11, 2026, at 7:00 am at the Osceola Town Hall (garage), Dresser, Wisconsin.

Discussion about current / future road projects

- Summer 2024 road projects:
 - 70th Ave- Monarch will look to refix pavement spring of 2026 (will mill back 25') will repave with 60th ave
- Summer 2026 road projects:
 - Spray Patching: 11.48 miles: 11 miles complete / xxxxx gallons of oil
 - Crack Seal:
 - Chip Seal: Completed 7 miles
 - Fog Seal: 6.91 miles
 - GSB 88:
 - Micro Seal: 2.56 miles: scheduled for end of August
 - Gravel Lift: 60th Ave completed
 - Pulverizing:
 - Paving:
 - 60th Ave 1 mile
 - pulverizing June15th & let the road settle for 3-weeks before paving
 - Dwight Court .08 miles & Dwight Lane .61 miles (next year)
 - Shouldering: 4.43 miles
 - Have started some
 - Line Stripping: 4.57 miles
 - Wedging:
 - Culverts: completed for this year
- Discussion on patching on repairing potholes as needed.
 - Have applied 1,700 gallons so far to potholes and cracks
- Ditch moving / brush trimming:
 - Buzz head seal went out: still wanting on parts
 - Start mowing ditches has started.
- Trees:
 - Picking up trees in ditches as required from storm this week:
- Sand / salt shed is low. We will need to get a couple more loads of salt.
 - About 3 loads left.
- Phaser Road Ratings:
- Road Grants: Looking at 210th Street
- Parks and Boat Landing
- Speed sign
 - Will install the sign on 210th to get vehicle counts near the campground for 3-weeks

Equipment:

- One ton truck dump:

- Discussion of potential future upgrade of one-ton truck. Possibly in 2028
- Old Mack Truck
 - Should replace steering tires in fall of 2026: \$2,000.
 - Need to fix wipers with winter service
- New Mack dump truck.
