Meeting Minutes

The Public Works Committee for the Town of Osceola met for a regular monthly meeting Thursday, July 23, 2026, at 7:00 am at the Osceola Town Hall (garage), Dresser, Wisconsin.

Call Meeting to Order: Chair Lindh called the meeting to order at 7:00 am.

Verification of Meeting Posting: It was confirmed that the notice was posted at the Town Hall, Dresser Post Office, the First National Community Bank, and the Town Web site.

Discussion about current / future road projects

- Summer 2024 road projects:
 - 70th Ave- Monarch will look to refix pavement in summer of 2026 (will mill back 25') will repave with 60th ave
- Summer 2026 road projects:
 - Spray Patching: 11.48 miles: 11 miles complete / done until the end of August
 - Crack Seal:
 - Chip Seal: Completed 7 miles (Todd figured cost \$16,570/mile without fog, \$22,000/mile with fog)
 - Fog Seal: Completed 6.91 miles (had to sand intersections due to recent higher temperatures and oil bleeding through rock)
 - GSB 88:
 - Micro Seal: 2.56 miles: completed
 - Gravel Lift: 60th Ave completed
 - Pulverizing:
 - Paving:
 - 60th Ave 1 mile
 - paving, completed
 - Dwight Court .08 miles & Dwight Lane .61 miles (next year)
 - Shouldering: 4.43 miles: start on Monday
 - HLine Stripping: 4.57 miles
 - Wedging: considering 205th Street
 - Culverts: considering adding culvert near 1919 70th Avenue
- Discussion on patching on repairing potholes as needed.
 - Have applied 1,700 gallons so far to potholes and cracks
- Ditch moving / brush trimming:
 - Buzz head seal went out: still wanting on parts
 - Have started the second pass
- Trees:
 - Picking up trees in ditches as required:
- Sand / salt shed is low. We will need to get a couple more loads of salt.
 - About 3 loads left.
- Phaser Road Ratings:
- Road Grants: Looking at 210th Street
- Parks and Boat Landing
- Speed sign
 - 60th Ave: 79 cars per day
 - 70th Ave: 37 cars per day
 - 93th Ave: 38 cars per day / over 13 days 401 cars (a couple of cars over 60 mph)
 - 110th Ave: 158 cars per day

Equipment:

- One ton truck dump:
 - Discussion of potential future upgrade of one-ton truck. Possibly in 2028
 - Needs to have general service completed
- Old Mack Truck
 - Should replace steering tires in fall of 2026: \$2,000.
 - Need to fix wipers with winter service
- New Mack dump truck.
 - No concerns
- Backhoe
 - No concerns
- Road Grader
 - No concerns
- Spray Patcher:
 - Making minor corrections- sensor went out
- Tractor

- Haygelman sidearm for mower
 - Had to replace hydraulic hose.
- Swiper:
 - Transmission when out- looking at options for replacement of machine. Replacing the transmission will be more expensive than the cost of the sweeper.
